Light Fabric: Cut 2 strips, $10^{\prime \prime} \times 1$ 1/2" Cut 4 squares, $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Cut 1 Square, 5 1/2"


Medium Fabric: $\quad$ Cut 1 Square, 5 1/2"
Medium Dark: $\quad$ Cut 2 strips, $10^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Dark Fabric: $\quad$ Cut 2 Squares, $5^{`} 1 / 2$
Center Square: Sew the four 10" x $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ stripes long sides together. Crosscut into $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sections. Assemble sections into the checkerboard square.

Corner Squares: Use the four $41 / "$ squares.


Side Squares: Layer one Dark Fabric $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square right sides together with a Light 5 1/2" Fabric square and the other with a Medium $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric square. Follow the directions for quick quarter
 square triangles*. Pair each Light/Dark Unit with a Light/Medium Unit and sew together in squares, matching long sides of the triangles.

Square up all units to $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and assemble the block according to the shaded diagram.
${ }^{*}$ To make quarter square triangles: On the back of the lighter of the fabrics, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Then another line diagonally from corner to corner making an X. These will be cutting lines. Then $1 / 4$ " on either side of one of the lines, draw 2 stitching lines.
 With two squares, right sides together, sew on the two outside stitching lines. Then cut into 2 halves on the line between the two stitching lines. Then divide those two parts on the other line. Press out and you will have $4,1 / 4$ square triangles.
**To make half square triangle blocks: On the back of the lighter of the fabrics, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Then $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on either side of this cutting line, draw 2 stitching lines. With two squares, right sides together, sew on the two outside stitching lines. Then cut into 2 halves on the line between the two stitching lines. Press out and you will have 2, half square triangle blocks.


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
