# 2024 BOM, Celebrate Block 1, Happy New Year

### Dark or Focus Fabric:

Cut 1 Square, 4 1/2"
Cut 2 Squares, 3" each
Cut 2 Squares, 5" each Divide each diagonally you w

Cut 2 Squares, 5" each. Divide each diagonally, you will have 4 triangles.

## Light Fabric:

12 1/2" x 12 ½"
Cut 6 Squares, 3" each
Cut 4 Rectangles, 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Repeat to make the other short side.

## Medium Fabric:

Cut 1 Square 5 1/4". Divide diagonally twice into 4 triangles.

#### Medium Dark:

Cut 4 Squares, 3" each.


**Center Square**: Sew one of the medium triangles to one side of the 4 1/2" dark square. Repeat with a second medium triangle on the opposite side. Press triangles out, Sew the other two medium triangles to the other sides.

Using the block you just created sew the 4 dark triangles to the sides to create the center square. This square should measure 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"

**Sides**: Pair the 4 medium/dark 3" squares, right sides together with 4 light squares and make half square triangle blocks.\*\* Repeat with the dark and light 3" squares. Square to 2 1/2".

Using 2 dark/light HST, 2 med/light HST and 1 2 1/2" rectangle make one of the long side pieces. Repeat to make the other long side.


Sew the two long side pieces to the other sides of the center block.



Using the shaded diagram as a guide, sew the short side pieces to opposite sides of the center block.

\*\*To make half square triangle blocks: On the back of the lighter of the fabrics, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Then 1/4" on either side of this cutting line, draw 2 stitching lines. With two squares, right sides together, sew on the two outside stitching lines. Then cut into 2 halves

on the line between the two stitching lines. Press out and you will have 2, half square triangle blocks.
