

Garden Fence Block

10" finished block (10 1/2" unfinished)

Cutting Instructions

Center square (print):

1 – 4 1/2" square

White (need 32" of 1 1/2" wide fabric):

2 – 1 1/2" x 4 1/2"


2 – 1 1/2" x 6 1/2"

4 – 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Borders (solid or print) (need 32" of 2 1/2" wide fabric):

4 – 2 1/2" x 3"

4 – 2 1/2" x 5"




Use primary and secondary colors: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, or purple.

Directions

Step 1 – Make center unit:

Sew a 4 1/2" white strip to each side of 4 1/2" square. Press toward center. Sew a 6 1/2" white strip to top and bottom of center unit. Press away from center.



Step 2 – Make borders:

Side units: Sew a 2 1/2" white strip between two 3" border pieces. Repeat with other set. Press toward border pieces.



Top/bottom units: Sew a 2 1/2" white strip between two 5" border pieces. Repeat with other set. Press toward border pieces.



Step 3 – Attach borders to center unit:

Sew one side unit to each side of center unit. Press toward borders.

Sew one top/bottom unit to top and bottom of center unit. Press toward borders.

Trim to 10 1/2" square, if necessary.
