

# Traditional and Curvy Workshop

with Daisy Aschehoug

## Overview:

This workshop covers the basics of design development, quilt math, and curved piecing skills. Our focus will be on modifying a traditional block that uses half square triangles. If you'd like to do optional workshop prep, have a few images of traditional blocks available to look at as we work - either saved digitally or printed out. Workshop outcomes will be (1) your own quilt block plan, (2) confidence sewing curves and precise quarter circle squares.

## Tools, Materials and Fabric:

- Paper and pencil - grid or graph paper, if possible.
- Traditional quilt block images (We'll use the attached worksheet for the Empire Star block as a warm up).
- Calculator (optional)
- At least 3 coordinating fabrics - a minimum of a 4" strip of each color. If you'd like to plan enough for a 20-block quilt project, I recommend having between 2-2.5 yards of each color. Do not precut fabric before the workshop.
- Templates (included in this document)
- Optional: 1/4 inch glue pen from Fons & Porter, Sewline, or other manufacturer.

\*\*\*BE SURE YOU PRINT TEMPLATES ACTUAL SIZE. Some printers scale to fit the page without being asked to. Use the 1 inch scale box to check that your printer is on the correct setting.

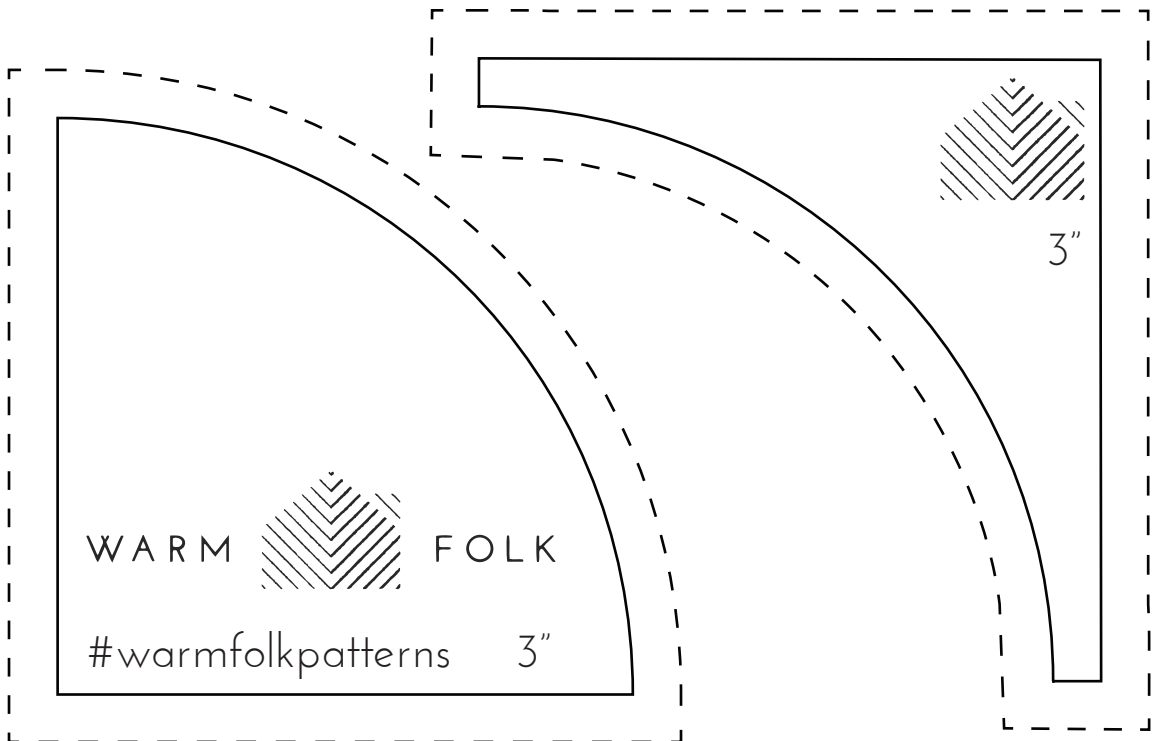
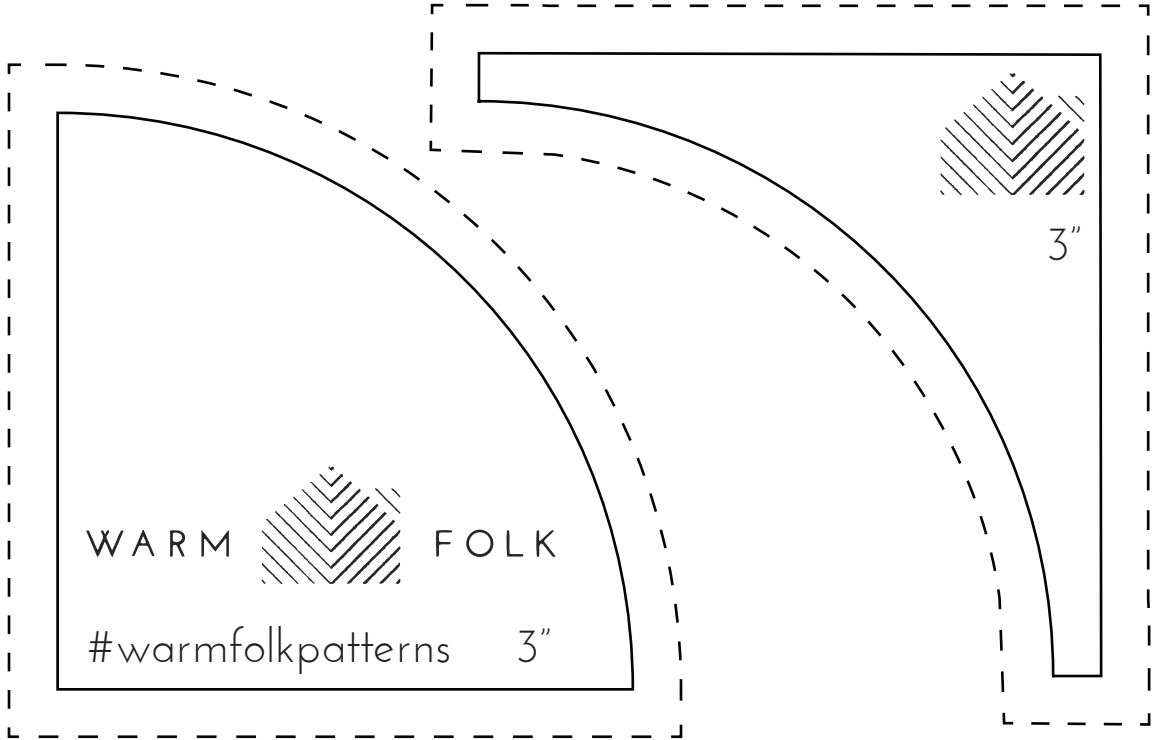
