## Diamond Star November



Medium Fabric: Cut 1 square, 4 1/2"
Cut 4 Squares, 2"
Dark Medium fabric: Cut 4 squares, 2 1/2"
Light Fabric: Cut 4 squares, $41 / \mathbf{2 "}^{\prime \prime}$
Cut 1 Square, $51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, Divide diagonally twice for a total of 4 triangles.
Cut 4 squares $23 / 8$ ", Divide each diagonally into 2 triangles.
Dark Fabric Cut 4 Squares, 3 3/4", Divide each diagonally once for a total of 8 triangles.
Center square: Draw a diagonal line across the back of each dark medium $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place one $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square on one corner of the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ medium square. Sew corner to corner and trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ outside the sewing line. Repeat with a second $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square on the opposite corner. Finish the other two corners the same way.

## Corner Squares

Use the 4, 4 1/2" light squares
Side Squares: To one side of each 2" Medium Fabric square, sew a light triangle, matching short side of triangle to square. Then on each unit, sew a light triangle to the adjoining side.

Sew each of the Light/Medium triangle units to a dark triangle, matching short sides. To each of the remaining dark triangles, sew a light triangle, matching short sides Refer to the shaded diagram to make sure you have them on the correct sides.

Sew the dark/light triangles together with the dark/medium/light triangles, matching long sides.


Square up each unit to $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and assemble the block according to the shaded block.
This block is a bit tricky. Take time to be sure all the pieces are oriented correctly before you sew them. Sew all seams with a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.
