

Jacob's Ladder Variation Block

12" finished block (12 1/2" unfinished)

Cutting Instructions

Bright Fabric (any bright colors):

4 – 3 1/2" squares

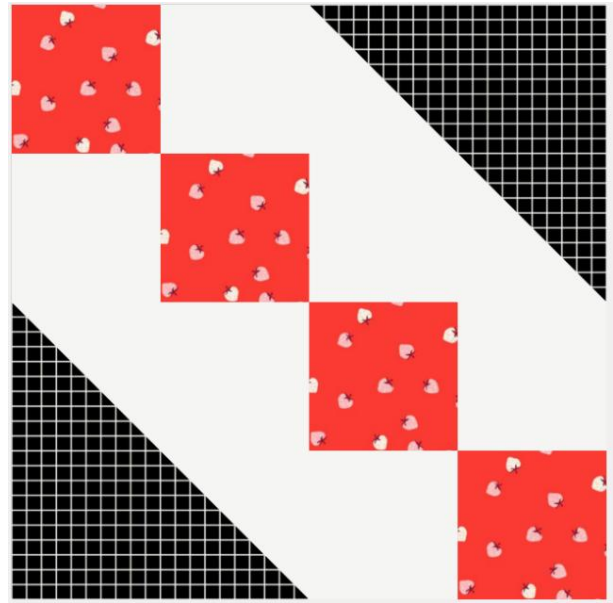
Black & White Print Fabric:

1 – 7" square

White Background Fabric:

4 – 3 1/2" squares

1 – 7" square



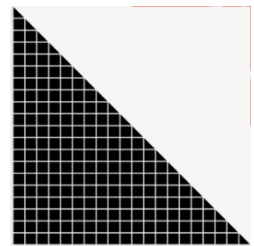
Directions

Step 1: Make 2 half square triangle blocks (HSTs).

Using the 1 black & white print and 1 white 7" squares, make 2 HSTs.

To make HSTs: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the white square. Pin the black & white print and the white square right sides together and stitch 1/4" away from each side of the drawn line.

Cut on the drawn line and press toward the black & white side. Trim to 6 1/2".

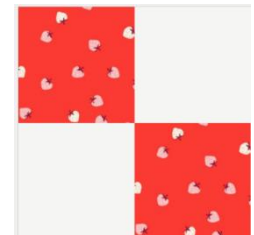


Step 2: Make 2 4-patch blocks.

Using the 3 1/2" squares, make 2 4-patch blocks, as shown.

Press. Trim to 6 1/2", if necessary.

Lay out the pieces to match the picture above.



Step 3:

Stitch a 4-patch to a HST, taking care to orient the blocks properly.

Repeat with the other set. Press.

Step 4:

Stitch the 2 rows together, matching the picture above and nesting the seams.

Press and trim to 12 1/2" square, if necessary.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO MEASURE AND SQUARE UP YOUR BLOCKS.
