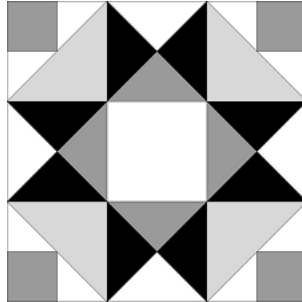


## Aunt Dinah's Star Block 6 - May



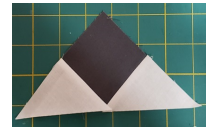
**Light Fabric:** Cut 1 square, 4 1/2"  
 Cut 4 squares, 2 7/8" Divide each diagonally for a total of 8 triangles.  
 Cut 1 square, 5 1/4"

**Medium Fabric:** Cut 2 squares, 4 7/8". Divide each diagonally for a total of 4 triangles.

**Med Dark Fabric:** Cut 4 squares, 2 1/2"  
 Cut 1 square, 5 1/4"

**Dark Fabric:** Cut 2 squares 5 1/4"

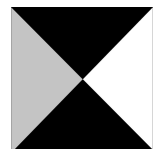
**Corner Squares:** Sew 2 light fabric triangles to adjoining sides of 1 Med Dark fabric square, matching a short side of the triangles to the side of the square. Make 4 units.



Sew each of the resulting triangles to a medium fabric triangle, matching long sides.



**Side Squares:** Layer one Dark square right sides together with a Light square and the other Dark square with a Medium square. Make quick quarter square triangle blocks.\* Pair each Light/Dark unit with a Dark/Medium unit and sew together in squares, matching long sides of the triangles.



**Center square:** Use the 4 1/2" light square.

Square all sections up to 4 1/2" and assemble the block according to the shaded diagram.

**\*To make quarter square triangles:** On the back of the lighter of the fabrics, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Then another line diagonally from corner to corner making an X. These will be cutting lines. Then 1/4" on either side of one of the lines, draw 2 stitching lines. With two squares, right sides together, sew on the two outside stitching lines. Then cut into 2 halves on



the line between the two stitching lines. Then divide those two parts on the other line. Press out and you will have 4, 1/4 square triangles.
